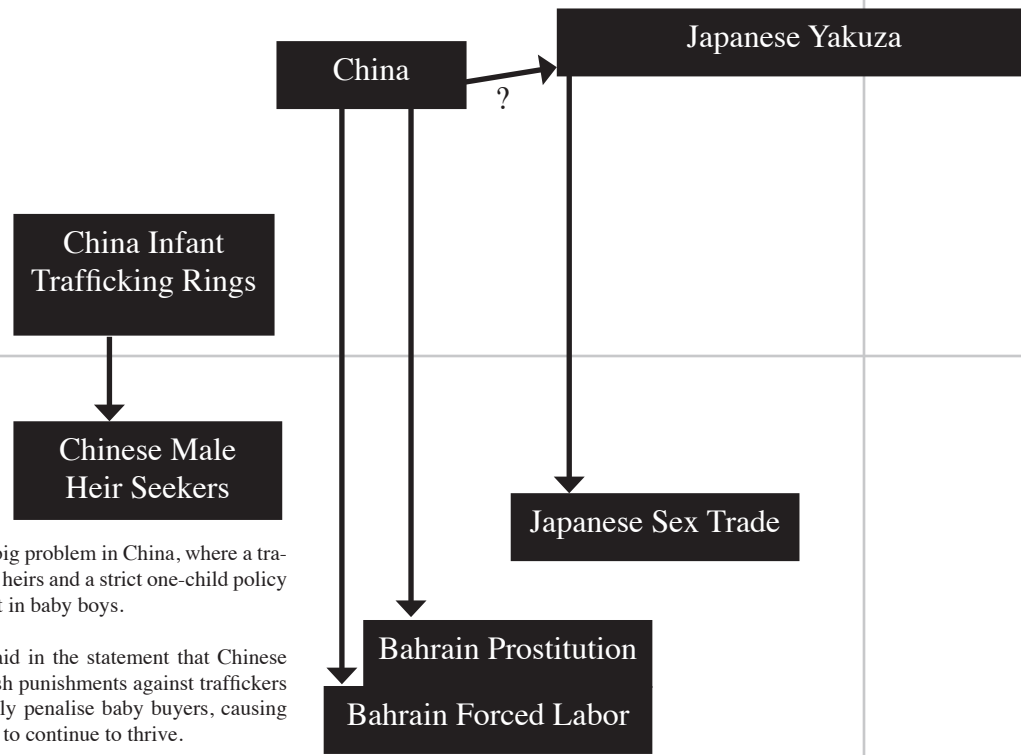

Trafficking in children is a big problem in China, where a traditional preference for male heirs and a strict one-child policy has driven a thriving market in baby boys.

Chief Judge Li Xuesong said in the statement that Chinese courts usually mete out harsh punishments against traffickers but have failed to adequately penalise baby buyers, causing the black market for infants to continue to thrive.
